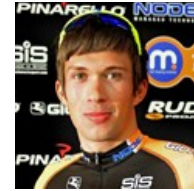

Ian Bibby (Motorpoint Pro Cycling Team) finishes 2nd in the Lincoln Grand Prix Premier Calendar race on Sunday, 8th May 2011.

Professional cyclist, **Ian Bibby** of the Motorpoint Pro Cycling Team is a regular client at **NJD Sports Injury Clinic**. Ian had his routine biomechanical check 3 days before the Lincoln Grand Prix race. Bibby, a former National Cyclo-Cross Champion first approached **NJD Sports Injury Clinic** in 2008, complaining of problems relating to asymmetry while cycling. A lower-limb biomechanical assessment revealed pelvic dysfunction due to excessive pronation. A rehab programme, manual therapy, and varus wedges were prescribed.

Scott Thwaites (Endura Racing) won the prestigious event, Bibby took 2nd place and Johnny McEvoy grabbed 3rd in an exciting race that kept a packed Lincoln crowd fixated right to the line. The photo to the right shows Thwaites ahead of Bibby just before the finish line at the top of the cobbled climb of Michaelgate. Bibby lost a lead of over 10 seconds on the final lap.
